1 RULES

1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc will apply.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board(s) located at CYC and CCYS

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

8 THE COURSES

Division 1
Course 6
Division 2
Course 6

Any course changes will be advised via vhf ch.72 at the radio check prior to the start.

8.2 Shortened course as per The Racing Rules of Sailing.

9 THE START

9.1 The starting line is the full CYC start line, with a limit marker placed outside of the dinghy course. Boats are to start between the limit marker and the eastern end of the line.

9.2 Races will be started by using rule 26 with the warning signal given 5 minutes before the starting signal at 1200.

9.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the race is 1155.

10 RADIO CHECK

10.1 Each vessel will perform a radio check with the starter on VHF ch72 at least 10 minutes prior to the start of the race.

THIS CALL WILL BE INITIATED BY THE STARTER. PLEASE DO NOT INITIATE THE RADIO CHECK YOURSELF.

11 THE FINISH

11.1 The finishing line will be a line between the Finisher on the northern end of the CYC deck and the club buoy.

11.2 Take own finish time for notification via race declaration form.

12 TIME LIMITS

12.1 Time limits are as follows:
All divisions 1730.

13 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

13.1 Protest forms are available at the race office. Protests shall be delivered there within the protest time limit.

13.2 For each class, the protest time limit is 90 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day.

13.3 Decisions of the [protest committee/jury] will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

14 SAFETY REGULATIONS

14.1 A boat retiring from a race shall notify the race committee/radio vessel as soon as possible.

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing (other than those required by radio schedules) nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during, or after the race.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability

insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
